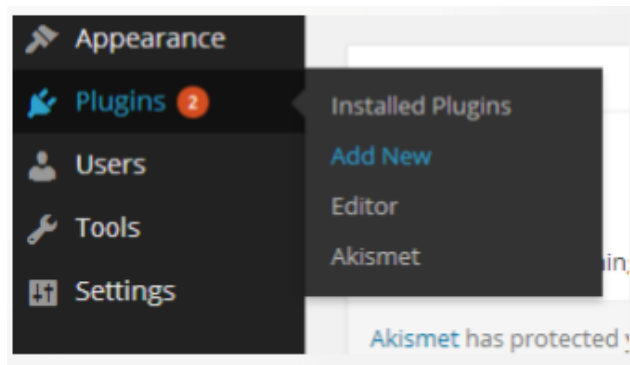
Pre-Conditions of Installation

- ✓ Have installed WooCommerce

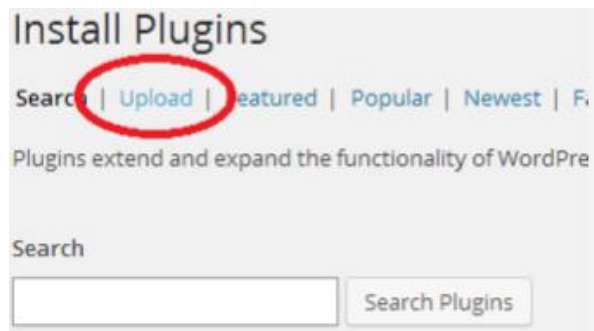


Installation Steps

1. Please login Wordpress dashboard.
2. Click Plugin > Add New



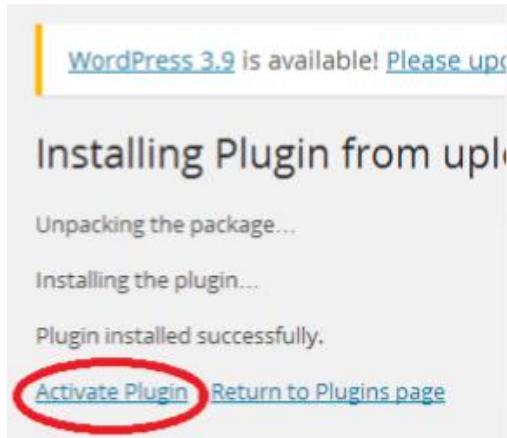
3. Click upload > Choose File – Select the eGHL plugin (in zip)



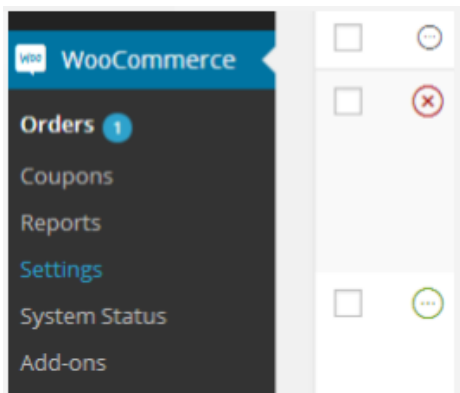


Installation Steps

4. Click Activate Plugin



5. Click WooCommerce > Settings.





Installation Steps

6. Click Checkout > eGHL (under Checkout Option).
7. Please enter your production eGHL Merchant ID in “**eGHL Merchant Service ID**” column and eGHL Merchant Password in “**eGHL Merchant Password**” column.

eGHL works by sending the user to eGHL to enter their payment information.
